COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County

The Warren County Health Department is confirming 1 additional COVID-19 related death. The individual was a male between the ages of 60-80. Our deepest sympathy goes out to family and friends. We continue to urge our community to do what you can to slow the spread of the virus.

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 6 additional confirmed case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 1567. 1497 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 9712 negative tests and 45 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.
