COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County April 18 – April 24, 2021

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 18 additional confirmed case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 1728 (correction in total from 2/15/2021). 1665 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 49 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.

IDPH uses numerous indicators when determining warning signs of increased risk in the county. A county is considered at a warning level when at least two of the following metrics trigger a warning.
