COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County June 20– June 26, 2021

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 4 additional confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 1818. 1762 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 52 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.
