### COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County June 27– July 3, 2021

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 2 additional confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 1820. 1766 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 52 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.

New cases include:

County level COVID-19 metrics for **Week 25** from **June 20-June 26, 2021** for Warren County remain **STABLE**. IDPH uses numerous indicators when determining warning signs of increased risk in the county. A county is considered at a warning level when at least two of the following metrics trigger a warning.
