### COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County September 19 – September 25, 2021

The Warren County Health Department is confirming 2 additional COVID-19 related deaths. The individuals were a male between the ages of 80-100 and a female between the ages of 80-100. Our deepest sympathy goes out to family and friends. We continue to urge our community to do what you can to slow the spread of the virus and to get vaccinated.

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 57 additional confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 2242. 2099 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 64 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.
