### COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County January 9 – January 15, 2022

The Warren County Health Department is confirming 4 additional COVID-19 related deaths. The individuals were two males between ages of 40-60, one male between the ages of 60-80 and one male between the ages of 80-100. Our deepest sympathy goes out to family and friends. We continue to urge our community to do what you can to slow the spread of the virus and to get vaccinated

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 247 additional confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 3422. 3208 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 76 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.
