COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County January 16 – January 22, 2022

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 129 additional confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 3551. 3299 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 76 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.

County level COVID-19 metrics for **Week 2** from **January 9 – January 15, 2022** for Warren County indicate we still have **high community transmission**. IDPH uses numerous indicators when determining warning signs of increased risk in the county. A county is considered at a warning level when at least two of the following metrics trigger a warning.
