COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County February 6 – February 12, 2022

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 56 additional confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 3854. 3758 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 79 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.

County level COVID-19 metrics for **Week 5** from **January 30 – February 5, 2022** for Warren County indicate we still have **high community transmission**. IDPH uses numerous indicators when determining warning signs of increased risk in the county. A county is considered at a warning level when at least two of the following metrics trigger a warning.
