COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County February 27 – March 5, 2022

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 14 additional confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 3907. 3814 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 81 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.
