COVID-19 Case Update in Warren County March 20 – March 26, 2022

The Warren County Health Department is confirming 1 additional COVID-19 related death. The individual was a male between the ages of 60-80. Our deepest sympathy goes out to family and friends. We continue to urge our community to do what you can to slow the spread of the virus and to get vaccinated.

The Warren County Health Department is announcing 3 additional confirmed case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19), bringing the total cases to 3913. 3830 cases have had their symptoms resolve. Due to federal privacy restrictions, release of any additional information is prohibited. To date there have been 83 confirmed COVID-19 related deaths.

County level COVID-19 metrics for **Week 11** from **March 13 – March 19, 2022** for Warren County indicate we have **low community transmission**. IDPH uses numerous indicators when determining warning signs of increased risk in the county. A county is considered at a warning level when at least two of the following metrics trigger a warning.
